PUBLIC PETITION AGAINST 5G TECHNOLOGY IN (CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA AND WALES)

We would like to bring to your attention to the large number of SWANSEA'S community who feel very strongly about the proposed introduction, installation and operation of 5G technology within the City and surrounding area.

Their primary concern is that this new and unprecedented introduction, installation and operation of 5G technology, has not had any official safety tests which are credible or broad spectrum health risk assessments before the nation is to be exposed to it.

It is extremely likely to cause significant health issues for the people who are exposed to it, with unknown long term health effects, especially for the young children of this current time.

Our own UK Government is the financial driving force behind 5G but they have never said nor categorically stated that it is a safe, time proven technology without health risks. There are many eminent scientists and health officials, even within the World Health Organisation, expressing their most serious concerns about exposure to 5G. As a result a growing amount of countries, towns, cities and American states, who have taken a good look at the facts and potential health risks, have decided to say no to 5G until at least there are meaningful tests and health assurances.

To demonstrate that there are real and genuine health concerns in CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA (AND WALES) community about the onset and roll out of 5G, the undersigned people whom you serve, and are answerable to, have asked to have their collective views respected, represented, and acknowledged within this petition.

There is an expectation that you will respond to the community concerns and both liaise, and consult with them, and say no to 5G under the Precautionary Principle in SWANSEA (AND WALES) until it is categorically proved, in proper randomised controlled trials, to be safe.

THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS ENDORSE THIS PETITION AND REQUEST THAT CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA (AND WELSH GOVERNMENT) RESPOND TO THE COMMUNITY WITH A FAVOURABLE STANCE AND PRECAUTIONARY POLICY TO SAY NO TO 5G IN THIS TOWN (AND ACROSS WALES).
